If I, the vendor, sells anything that harms a person or injures anyone in any way, knowingly or unknowingly, over the course of the market day, then I be the target of any claim or lawsuit. I forever discharge all parties, including the Saint Louis Street Market, its administrators, agents, and all other persons, firms, corporations, and institutions, which might be claimed liable by the customers that I serve.</li> <li>2. The undersigned hereby releases and forever discharges Saint Louis Street Market, its administrators, agents, and all other persons, firms, corporations and institutions (including without limitation the owner of the land on which the market is held and its lender), who it might be claimed to be liable, none of whom admit any liability from any and all claims, demands, actions, causes of action or suits of any kind or nature whatsoever and particularly on account of all injuries known and unknown, both to person and property, which have resulted or may in the future develop from any accident which might occur as a result of any market event or activity sponsored by the Saint Louis Street Market. The undersigned hereby declares that the terms of this settlement have been completely read and are fully understood and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full and final compromise adjustment and settlement of any and all claims, stipulated or otherwise, on account of the injuries and damages above mentioned, and for the express purposes of precluding forever any further or additional claims arising out of any possibility accident by the undersigned.</li> <li>3. It is further agreed that the release expresses a full and complete settlement of liability, regardless of the adequacy of the aforesaid and that the acceptance of this release shall not operate as an admission of the liability on the part of anyone or bar with respect to any claim the parties release may have against the undersigned</li> <li>4.
